2022 Destiny M Martin Legacy Scholarship

Eligibility Requirements

The applicant must:

- Attend high school (Galveston County/ Brazoria County)
- Be an African-American graduating high school senior
- Be in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Plan to enroll full-time, in a four-year degree program, at a US-accredited, private, or public college or university, with a declared major in science, technology, engineering, and/or math

Instructions

Each applicant must submit a completed application that includes the following documents:

- PERSONAL STATEMENT: Please describe the reason(s) you decided to pursue a college education and career in STEM. What is the impact you wish to make on society through your career goals? How will your major be the vehicle to drive that impact to fruition? (double spaced, font size 12pt)
- RESUME: A resume that includes your work experience, extra-curricular activities, community service, and accomplishments.
- TRANSCRIPT: An official up-to-date transcript that includes grades for the 1st semester of high school senior year.
- ACCEPTANCE LETTER: Letter of admission to a four-year degree program with a declared major in science, technology, engineering, and/or math
- 2 LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: 2 letters of recommendation (letters from family members are not acceptable)
- PROFESSIONAL PHOTO: A professional photo should be included (no selfies)
